Admission requirements

For admission to HZ a student needs:

- A diploma that is equivalent to the Dutch Secondary Education Diploma, which gives access to higher education.
- An official English test that is equivalent to an IELTS score of 6.0.

Application procedure

Application is via [studielink.nl](https://www.studielink.nl). The closing date for application is 1 June for non-EU students and 1 August for EU-students.

Costs

The tuition fees for the academic year 2026-2027 are:

- €2.695 for EU students
- €9.893 for non-EU students
